By car

You can find us on your Sat.Nav.

- 1) Follow the signs for Town Centre
- 2) Join the Ring Road, get into Car Parks lane
- 3) Follow signs for Citipark Church Car Park
- 4) After entering the car park keep left following the signs for Shopmobility.

* Height restriction: approx. 1.9m (6' 3")

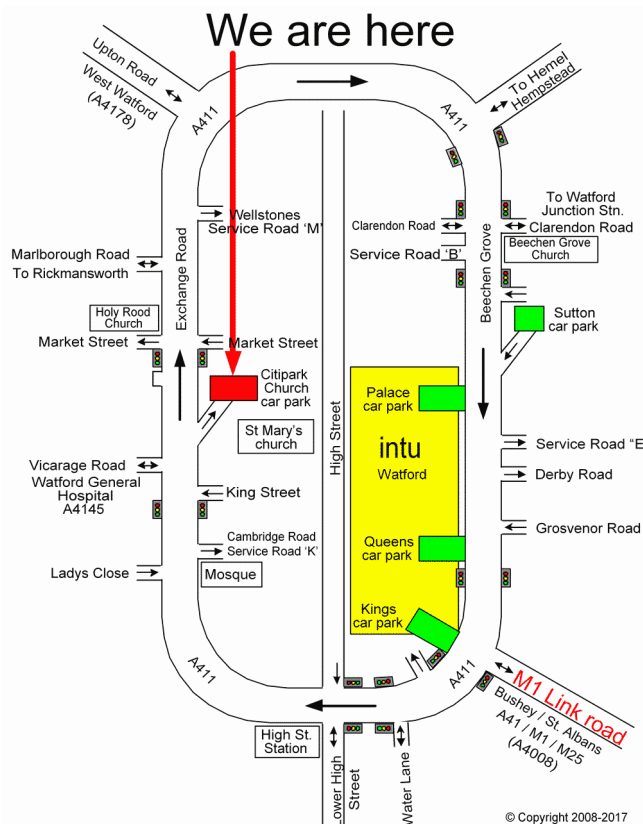
* Car park charges apply - drop off free (time restrictions apply)

By foot or public transport

- 1) Cross High Street opposite BHS (Closed).
- 2) Church Car Park is behind The One Bell Public House (Closed).
- 3) The entrance walkway is on the rear left side of the car park.
- 4) Once inside the car park you will see a large Shopmobility sign.

Drop off point for taxis (over 6' 3") and Dial-a-Ride

- 1) Service road (New Street) behind Citipark Church Car Park
- 2) The entrance walkway is on the rear left side of the car park.

Shopmobility Watford is a local charity which loans manual and battery powered wheelchairs and scooters to anyone with a mobility problem, whether permanent or temporary, through accident, illness or age. It gives users greater independence to do their own shopping, visit libraries, banks etc. or for leisure.

This service is **FREE for daily use** in Watford town centre (from Tesco Extra to Watford Town Hall). This includes into Watford shopping centre.

How do I join?

- ✓ Call personally at the office
- ✓ Bring **two** forms of identification showing your name and address i.e. **Driving licence, Utility bill, Bank statement etc.**
- ✓ Complete a simple registration form
- ✓ A member of staff will help you choose the most suitable vehicle.
- ✓ For scooters and power chairs – you will need to complete an insurance assessment and safety

Do I need to book?

It is not necessary to book, except at peak times like Christmas. If you prefer a particular vehicle it is advisable to ring in advance.



What equipment is there?

We have a selection of 3 or 4 wheeled scooters and 4 and 6 wheeled powerchairs (left & right hand control). A range of self-propelled and attendant controlled adult and junior wheelchairs. If you have a particular need please let us know.

What else do we do?

- For your added comfort we can provide blankets, waterproof capes, cushions, shopping bags and extendable leg rests for manual chairs.
- A long term loan scheme for manual wheelchairs enabling you to take the chair away for holidays etc. or use in your own home.
- We sell reconditioned scooters & wheelchairs.
- We provide a service for organised groups (i.e. Residential homes, clubs) with prior notice.
- A range of information leaflets
